

All enjoying our first night Gutter Party out of the back of the truck.






The party went on, it was a great night.

From Hobart we travelled to Swansea then on to the animal sanctuary.









Stopped for morning tea.

The show proved very popular with the public and we possibly picked up 3 potential new members.


